Prior to that appointment, Ms. Wright was named by Major David N. Dinkins to the New York City Housing Authority Board,

which manages New York City's 189,000 public housing units.

Ms. Wright serves on the boards of Kraft Foods Inc., Time Warner, The Partnership for New York City, The Children's Defense Fund and Sesame Workshop. She is a member of the Board of Managers of the Memorial Sloan-Kettering Cancer Center and served as a member of the Board of Overseers of Harvard University. She earned A.B., J.D. and M.B.A. degrees from Harvard University.

The luncheon will be held on the Executive Dining floor of Merrill Lynch's offices at 250 Vesey Street and will provide an opportunity to network with other FWA and non-member attendees.
