



## HOW TO JOIN THE WALL STREET EXCHANGE PROGRAM

### REQUIREMENTS

To qualify for participation in the Wall Street Exchange, an applicant must have the following:

- An interest in exploring careers in finance or business
- Minimum cumulative G.P.A of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale
- Completion of the junior year in college
- A summer position in the New York City metropolitan area with a financial services company or a financial position with a non-financial services company.

### PROCEDURES

A candidate must complete an application form, which is available at your college placement office or on the FWA website ([www.fwa.org](http://www.fwa.org)). The College Connections Committee requires an official college transcript as part of the application submission and two recommendations from each student applicant. At least one must be an academic recommendation; the other may be an additional academic recommendation or a reference from an employer with whom you have worked in the past 18 months. **Do not delay your application submission as you wait to finalize your summer employment situation.** While the prerequisite for qualification is a summer position in the New York City metro area with a financial services company or a financial position with a non-financial services company, applicants who are completing the job interview process will be considered for the Wall Street Exchange Program. Your summer job employment status will be confirmed in late May when the College Connections Committee contacts applicants with follow-up questions or to notify applicants of acceptance to the program.
